

How the Anchor Works

The Breakaway Anchor is designed to deliver reliable holding power in a variety of seabed conditions, while ensuring safe and efficient release when retrieval forces exceed the preset breakaway threshold.

Function Overview:

- During deployment, the shovel blade penetrates and sets into the seabed under tension.
- The link and pin mechanism distribute load evenly across the anchor body, maximizing hold.
- Upon excessive retrieval force (e.g., snagging), the link disengages, allowing the anchor to release upward without damage.
- The system is resettable for the next deployment.

Design Advantages:

- Corrosion-resistant marine grade 316L stainless steel construction.
- Resettable breakaway design for safety and reusability.
- Optimized geometry for strong holding in sand, mud, or clay.

Figure 4. BA21A Anchor Assembly View – Reference dimensions shown in inches (for illustration only).




Figure 5. BA24A Anchor Assembly View – Reference dimensions shown in inches (for illustration only).





Figure 6. BA32A Anchor Assembly View - Reference dimensions shown in inches (for illustration only).

Deployment & Retrieval Procedures

Safety Precautions:

- Always wear protective gloves and eye protection when handling anchors and chains.
- Never stand directly over the anchor during deployment or retrieval.
- Inspect all fasteners and linkages before each use. Replace any worn components immediately.

Deployment Procedure

Follow the steps below each time you deploy the Breakaway Anchor:

Inspect the Anchor Assembly

Check the anchor, chain, Breakaway mechanism, and all fasteners for signs of wear, deformation, or corrosion. Replace components as needed.

Secure the Chain Connection

Ensure the chain connection is properly fastened over the retaining pins, and that the retaining pins are fully inserted and locked in place using the supplied clips and cotter pin.

Lower the Anchor Slowly

Lower the anchor in a controlled manner until it contacts the seabed.
Do not throw or drop the anchor overboard.

Set Proper Scope (7:1 Ratio)

Pay out anchor line to achieve the recommended **7:1 scope ratio** (line length : water depth) for optimal holding strength.

Set the Anchor

Apply gradual, steady tension to the anchor line until the vessel comes under load.
Confirm the anchor has engaged and the vessel is holding securely.

Retrieval Procedure

Under normal conditions, retrieve the Breakaway Anchor as you would a traditional anchor:

Position the Vessel

Move the vessel directly above the anchor's position.

Retrieve the Line Steadily

Pull upward until the anchor breaks free and rises normally.

Breakaway Release Procedure (If Anchor Becomes Stuck)

If the anchor does not become free using standard retrieval:

Reposition the Vessel

Move directly over the anchor's last known location. If needed, continue slightly **past** that point to pull from the opposite direction of the original set.

Apply Upward Tension

Begin retrieving the anchor line to create controlled, upward pressure.

Activate the Breakaway Release Mechanism

Maintain steady line tension. The Breakaway mechanism will release, allowing the anchor to shift opposite of the obstruction and free itself.

Retrieve the Anchor

Once released, the anchor should rise freely to the surface.

Post-Retrieval Reset

After the anchor is on board:

Clean the Anchor Assembly

Rinse off debris, sand, or vegetation.

Inspect Breakaway Mechanism

Check for wear, bent components, or corrosion.

Reattach & Reset

Reinstall the Breakaway mechanism per the resetting anchor link steps and ensure all clips and pins are properly secured.

Verify Ready for Use


Ensure the anchor is fully reassembled and operational before redeployment.

Resetting Anchor Link

Follow the steps below to reset the Breakaway Anchor link:


Place the Link on the Cam Pin

Take the detached link and place it over the cam pin with the cam oriented as shown.




Rotate the Cam to Lock the Link

Using the provided Allen wrench, rotate the cam pin (counterclockwise or clockwise) 90 degrees, allowing the link to lock over the cam pin.

Figure 1. BA21A Anchor Assembly Exploded View – Reference (for illustration only).





Figure 2. BA24A Anchor Assembly Exploded View – Reference (for illustration only).





Troubleshooting

Chain Replacement Procedure

Unlock the Link

Use the provided Allen wrench to turn the cam pin and unlock the link.

Remove the Existing Pins

With the link now detached, remove the rear SS Clip Pin and the 5/16" SS Clip Pin (link end) by unclipping the C-clips and removing the pins.

Remove the Chain

The chain is now free from the anchor and can be swapped with a new replacement chain.

Install the New Chain


Place the new chain into the anchor by sliding the 3/8" SS Clip Pin and 5/16" SS Clip Pin back through the anchor holes and the link holes, ensuring the chain surrounds the pins.

Install the Clips

Ensure the clips are placed onto the pins.

Lock the Link in Place

Use the provided Allen wrench to lock the link back into place.



Link Replacement Procedure

Unlock the Link

Use the provided Allen wrench to turn the cam pin (counterclockwise or clockwise) releasing and unlocking the link from the anchor body.

Remove the Existing Retaining Pins

Remove the 5/16" stainless-steel c-clip and cotter pin:

- Pull out the clip/cotter pin from retaining pins.
- Remove the retaining pin to free the link from the anchor chain and user's line.

Remove and Replace the Link

Remove the old link and install the new link. The link is symmetrical and may be installed in either direction.

Reattach the Chain & Line

Attach the new link to the anchor's supplied chain and the user's line. Reinsert retaining pins so the chain and line are captured.

- Install the clip on the chain-side pin.
- Install the cotter pin on the user-line-side pin.

Lock the Link in Place

Use the provided Allen wrench to turn the cam pin and lock the link securely into place.
